Dear Mr. ROBINS-BIRD,

Thank you for your enquiry to the ECHA Helpdesk concerning pre-registration of preparation Fuji Chemical NE3000S & Fuji Chemical NE8800K.

Please be informed that according to Article 6 of the REACH Regulation when substances are contained in a preparation, each individual substance needs to be registered, either by the substance manufacturer or the importer of the substance or preparation when reaching the threshold of 1 tonne per year. Therefore if you import preparation in existing amounts, you have no obligation to register substances and consequently there is no need for pre-registration.

Please be aware that you may have other obligations under REACH i.e. to provide SDS for preparations classified as dangerous (see Article 31 of the REACH Regulation).
